#### Commentary:

This Proposed Disposition of Ballot Comments documents the ballot comments received during the sponsor confirmation ballot on P802.1AB/D12 and records the resolutions of those ballot comments that will be discussed and agreed upon at the 802 plenary meeting to be held in San Antonio, Texas, during the week of November 14 through 19, 2004. The document contains:

- 1) A table of responses received during the initial sponsor ballot on P802.1AB/D10 as well as ballot comments reconfirmed or changed during the two reconfirmation ballots.
- 2) Listings of voter comments received during P802.1AB/D12 reconfirmation balloting. Each comment is accompanied by a disposition.

When approved, this document will constitute a record of the Instructions to the Editor for the preparation of P802.1AB/D13.

## 1. Table of Responses

The following table indicates the status of each ballot response received in the P802.1AB/D10 confirmation ballot. The Status column indicates the voting status of the responder. V(oting) indicates an eligible voting member of the ballot pool at the start of the ballot period. C(oordination) indicates a coordination response. The Vote column indicates the vote cast; Y = Approve, N = Disapprove, A = Abstain, C = Comment only.

Table 1 lists the eligible voters and coordinators in the ballot pool. Votes received during the draft 12 confirmation ballot are shown with a right arrow. The comment column indicates whether or not comments were received from the associated voter during draft 12 balloting.
