Why Hawaii ???

To Whom It May Concern:

For several years IEEE 802 has been looking for an opportunity to hold an IEEE 802 Plenary session in a location that would be more convenient for our attendees from the Far East and Australia. They have regularly travelled great distances, at high costs, to contribute to and support our LAN and MAN Standards activities. We believe that holding one of our plenary meetings in their part of the world would be a fine way of acknowledging their many contributions to our work, and would permit some of their colleagues to attend one of our sessions. This was already done for our European contributors in July of 1996, when we held our plenary session at the University of Twente in Enschede, Netherlands.

Unfortunately, the economic realities of the high costs to hold an 802 Plenary in Japan or Australia have thwarted our best efforts to find an acceptable venue there. Therefore we have selected a compromise site, namely Hawaii, where we can still get an American-style conference package-deal with the hotels. Hawaii requires 5 hours less flying-time each way, and about \$1,200 less expense for our Far Eastern and Australian attendees, while assuring us excellent meeting facilities with all the support and services we expect at our plenary meetings.

Some of our attendees have expressed their concern that Hawaii's widespread reputation as a "vacation spot" may cause their company management to view an 802 Plenary meeting held in Hawaii as "a company-paid vacation" or "a boondoggle," and to not approve their request to attend such a meeting. Because of this concern, I have agreed to draft this letter explaining the reasons for selection of the Hawaiian site. I would also like to provide assurance that this meeting will be a full working 802 Plenary session with excellent conference facilities that will ensure fully productive sessions for all of our 802 working groups.

We have made every effort to keep the costs for this Hawaiian meeting in line with the costs we have typically seen at our previous meetings. We are confident that the total costs for this meeting will not show more than a 10-15% increase for our US and European based attendees.

I hope to see you all present at our Hawaii meeting. I'm sure it will be one of our most productive meetings ever.
