#### Overview

At its last meeting, the IEEE 802.16 Broadband Wireless Access Working Group Study Group on Systems Operating below 10 GHz prepared a PAR, which was subsequently approved by the 802.16 Working Group for submittal to the 802 Executive Committee. This was done on 4 February 2000. On Monday, 6 March 2000, the PAR will be formally presented to the other 802 Working Groups for review and comment. Any comments are due back to the 802.16 Chair by 5:00 PM, Tuesday, 7 March. By 5:00 pm, Wednesday, 8 March, the final PAR, approved by the 802.16 Working Group, along with written responses to the comments, is due to the 802 ExCom. If this deadline is not met, the Executive Committee will not consider the proposed PAR at their closing session.

The Study Group also established an Ad Hoc on Functional Requirements with the intent to start preparation of a document to define the requirements for BWA systems operating below 11 GHz. A Call for Contributions was issued.

The agenda is intended to provide the maximum amount of time available to address any comments or proposed revisions to the PAR in order to meet the above deadline. Contributions on Functional Requirements will not be addressed until the PAR is completed. Should the PAR revisions not require the full amount of time allocated, consideration will be given to addressing the Functional Requirements contributions in earlier sessions.
