## Comment Resolution Tracks



- Global Section and Intro Section Clauses 2, 3, 4
  - 11 technicals; all dealt with, 2 rejected, 2 to WG
- Intro Section (Clause 1)
  - 17 technicals; all dealt with, 1 rejected, 0 to WG
- MAC Section (Clauses & Annexes)
  - 173 technicals, all dealt with, 12 rejected, 6 to WG
- PHY section
  - 13 technicals, all dealt with, 0 rejected, 1 to WG



## Comment Resolution Tracks



- Fairness Section
  - 44 technicals, all dealt with, 5 rejected, 2 to WG
- Topology Section
  - 88 technicals, all dealt with, 1 rejected, 4 to WG
- OAM Section
  - 60 technicals, all dealt with, 7 rejected, 1 to WG
- Bridging Section
  - 24 technicals, all dealt with, 0 rejected, 1 to WG

# Draft Creation/Posting Schedule (802.17



### (verrry tentative)

- 12 days for Editors to create D2.4 from comment resolutions
  - Starts 27<sup>th</sup> July; draft clauses sent to Chief Editor by August 7<sup>th</sup>
- 2 days to clean up, review and assemble D2.4
  - Update MIB to reflect changes in remainder of the draft
  - Draft 2.4 posted on August 10<sup>th</sup>
- Recirculation ballot period runs from August 10th to August 25th
  - 15 days to review draft and post comments
- Comment database posted for review by August 26<sup>th</sup>
  - 1 day to collate and assemble comment database
- Interim meeting starts August 27<sup>th</sup>
  - Runs from August 27<sup>th</sup> to August 29<sup>th</sup>

### **Process**



- Each section will be dealt with in turn
  - Order: Intro, Bridging, PHY, OAM, Topology, Fairness, MAC
- Editor will present summary of resolutions by ad-hoc
  - No more than **20 minutes per report**, including questions
- Comments punted to WG will then be debated and resolved
  - Any WG member can also request that any comment be broken out of the bucket and debated by WG as a whole
  - Chair will limit debate to **5 minutes each** in the interests of progress
- Single motion per section to accept ad-hoc group's resolutions to remainder of comments as a bucket
- Authorize creation and balloting of D2.4 based on instructions

### Clause 0 Comments



- Submitted to Clause 0: 13 comments (3 techbinding)
- All technical comments looked at
  - 1 deferred to WG, rest accepted/accept-modified
- Major issues
  - Field names
  - Index and terms clauses
  - Miscellaneous editorial and formatting stuff
- Deferred to WG:
  - New draft text



## Clause 2, 3, 4 Comments



- 27 comments; 7 technical/tech-binding
  - 2 technical non-binding rejected
    - Definitions for "available" and "unavailable"
  - All editorial stuff
    - Variables subclause (3.2) being removed in favor of index
    - Definitions and acronyms
    - Italics
    - State diagram format subclause (3.4.2) being removed because it's never used in the draft
    - Fonts, etc.
