Comment Resolution Tracks



- Global Section and Intro Section Clauses 2, 3, 4
 - 67 comments dealt with (incl. one punted in)
 - 3 punted to group (Comments #6, 7, 8)
- Intro Section (Clause 1)
 - 80 comments dealt with, 21 punted to WG
- MAC Section (Clauses & Annexes)
 - 220 comments dealt with, 30 punted to WG
- PHY section
 - 29 comments dealt with, 12 punted to WG



Comment Resolution Tracks



- Fairness Section
 - 125 comments handled, 3 punted to WG, 1 to Cls 6
- Topology/Protection Section
 - 67 technical comments dealt with, 7 punted to WG
- OAM Section
 - 61 technicals total, 7 punt to WG, 54 resolved
- Bridging Section
 - 42 comments dealt with, 0 punted

All Technical / Technical-Binding comments have been handled!



Process



- Each section will be dealt with in turn
 - Order: Clause 0/2/3/4, Bridging, Fairness, Topology/Protection, OAM,
 PHY, Clause 1, MAC
- Editor will present summary of resolutions by ad-hoc
 - No more than **15 minutes per report**, including questions
- Comments punted to WG will then be debated and resolved
 - Any WG member can also request that any comment be broken out of the bucket and debated by WG as a whole
 - Chair will limit debate to **5 minutes each** in the interests of progress
- Single motion per section to accept ad-hoc group's resolutions to resolved comments as a bucket
 - Ad-hocs to resolve issues raised by comments authorized at this time (by acceptance of comments)
- Authorize creation and balloting of D2.2 based on instructions



Draft Creation/Posting Schedule (802.17



(tentative, based on workload)

- 17 days for Editors to create D2.2 from comment resolutions
 - Draft clauses sent to Chief Editor by April 1st
- 3 days to clean up, review and assemble D2.1
 - Update MIB and incorporate global comments
 - Draft 2.1 posted on April 4th
- Ballot period runs from April 5th to May 6th
 - 30 days (+ 2 days slop) to review draft and post comments
- CRD posted for review by May 8th
 - 4 days to review comments prior to meeting
- Interim meeting starts March 12th (assumed)
 - If it starts May 19th, so much the better

Clause 0 Comments



- Submitted to Clause 0: 31 comments
 - 16 Technical Binding
 - 14 Editorial
- 28 comments resolved
 - Each clause should have subclause with variables used by MIB
 - Inconsistent word usage and capitalization
 - Table rulings
 - Representation of true-if-one values for variables
 - Miscellaneous editorial stuff
- 3 comments punted to WG
 - **-** #6, #7, #8



Clause 2, 3, 4 Comments



- 59 comments (including 1 punt): 36 resolved
 - 17 Technical-Binding, 9 Technical
 - All mostly editorial stuff
 - Inconsistent, incomplete or poor definitions
 - References
 - Italics
 - Capitalization
 - Readability issues
 - Only editorial comments remain unresolved
 - Will be requesting license
