#### 3. Action item status

- Items 10-19, 10-21 and 10-22 were complete prior to meeting.
- 10-17 completed during meeting.
- Added action items 10-23 and 10-31.
- 4. Specific items related to P1792.
  - a. George expressed the appreciation of the WG for the efforts of Tammy Womack and Mark Bowman in cleaning up and preparing the document for balloting.

- b. Successful ballot on first pass statistics
  - 1. Balanced ballot pool of 87
    - User 43%, General 37%, Gov't 13%, Others 7%
  - 2. Response rate 89% (77 of 87) ≥ 75%
  - 3. Approval rate 96% (72 of 75) ≥ 75%
- c. Ballot was above 75% approval so the recommended practice needs to proceed forward to publication.
- d. We must respond to negative comments and provide a recirculation ballot. Negative comments were organized based on general categories for discussion.
- e. WG reviewed the 13 <u>negative vote comments</u> and proposed responses in a detailed spreadsheet in the format provided by IEEE.
  - 1. WG elected to agree in principle and retain some comments to hold for next revision of the document.
  - 2. WG suggested some comments be covered as "editorial changes" by standards editor.
  - 3. WG reviewed comments to be provided to all "negative" balloters.
  - A motion was made by David Glady to accept disposition of comments and seconded by John Disosway. A voice vote was called and passed unanimously.
- f. A motion was made to proceed to recirculation ballot by Mark Bowman and seconded by Ken Miller. A voice vote was called and passed unanimously. The document will now proceed to the recirculation process.
- g. Consideration of a PAR for 1792 was proposed to review and consider all ballot comments and potential revision after the Spring of 2012.
- 5. Specific items related to IEEE 765 revision.
  - a. There were no comments from P1792 balloting resulting in technical changes for consideration in 765.
  - b. Mark and Tammy have agreed to mark up 765 and provide to George for circulation by 9/30 and prepare for SC-4 and NPEC preview.
    - 1. Plan to take to NPEC 12-01
    - 2. Ballot in early 2012
    - 3. Current Par in effect until end of 2012
- 6. An IEEE 765 Interpretation was requested after the 11-01 WG meeting. There was a significant delay in the receipt of the interpretation by IEEE and the request being delivered to the WG.
  - a. George discussed the issue with the Interpretation requestor.
  - b. Harvey Leake provided a response for the WG to consider.
  - c. George will discuss the disposition of the Interpretation given the current IEEE standards rules.

- 7. Next WG meeting will be held in conjunction with the SC-4 12-01 meeting if the need is determined by George Attarian.
