Additional information for Action item 12-3 closure: After description of review made by Kenn Miller, the working group has determined there are probable impact to both IEEE Stds. 765 and 1792. All members were asked to re-review the standards and send all members of the working group any additional issued documents which hold requirements for the transmission system.

Additional information for Action item 14-6 closure: NRC is in the process of producing a Reg Guide for endorsement of 765. While it a specific schedule for completion is not available, is in process and there are no anticipated technical reasons the NRC would not be able to complete this.

5. Specific Items Related to Standard 765

Due to an industry group question on open phase, the working group will continue to monitor the outcome and determine if additional requirements should be added to the standard.

Additional discussion of the relaxation of frequency requirements shows there are potential impacts to the standard. Additional review of published transmission requirements will be required in order to determine if changes are required. This topic will be reviewed in greater detail during the next working group meeting in 16-02.

6. Specific Items Related to Standard 1792

NPEC preview has been approved by SC-4 and will be presented at tomorrow's (16-01) meeting. Very limited comments, all editorial in nature, were received from members of NPEC.

As with Standard 765, Standard 1792 will have further evaluation for changes associated with relaxing the frequency requirements. Review of published requirements will be reviewed and determination if changes will be required. This topic will be reviewed in greater detail during the next working group meeting in 16-02.
