PAR Need for the Project: "This revision is to update the recommended practice from recent industry experience. Also to review the applicable previous ballot comments. References will be reviewed and revised as required. Technical content will be reviewed and brought up to date with current industry experience, as applicable.

- 1. Required:
 - a) Determine PAR need for project, motion, vote.
 - b) All WG members to review ballot comments identified in #2
- 2. Dispositioned Comments located in iMEET, NPEC WG 4.6 PPS, Draft Documents, 1792
 - a) Dispositioned comments from last ballot that must be reviewed for consideration (Dispositioned Comments for Upload (Next Rev Cons Highlighted).xls)
 - b) Listing of all comments from recent balloting efforts for 308, 741, and 765 (Joint Working Group Ballot Comments (Draft 0).xlsx)
- 3. Proposed:
 - a) Notification of terminology alignment requirements if any deviations from issued standards, must communicate prior to going out for review for standard we are revising
 - b) Review last 1792 ballot comments for consideration (5 total) document in meeting minutes working group determination to consider for this revision, comment is not beneficial to the standard, or hold for future consideration.
 - c) Assign a team to review/document Joint Working Group Ballot Comments for applicability to 1792.

Proposed Assignments/Work Needed between 23-01 and 23-02 meeting

- 1. PAR Initiated through NPEC (assigned to WG 4.6 leadership)
- 2. Review Joint Comments for applicability to 1792 (assigned to all members)
 - a) Team to set up and hold a virtual review (meeting or electronically) which meets quorum requirements set forth by IEEE SA this will be counted as an official meeting with meeting minutes, WG leadership to be present.
 - b) Team to distribute documented applicability for comments at least 2 weeks prior to the virtual review
 - c) Working group members, by majority agreement, determine final applicability
 - d) Summarized topics will be documented in meeting minutes and uploaded to iMeet
- 3. Summary of items/topics to consider for 1792 revision ≥45 days prior to 23-02 meeting

IEEE SA recording policy

"IEEE SA applies restrictions on recording the proceedings of IEEE standards development meetings. Restrictions include, but are not limited to, the usage of audio recording, video recording, and photography by participants or observers."

Recommendation from IEEE-SA staff about taking photos of awards, etc.

- Keep <u>standards development</u> portions of meetings separate from tutorials, award ceremonies, and other non-development activities.
- Make the separation clear on any agendas or session descriptions.
- If attendees request permission for photos ahead of time, any such permission cannot subvert the Ops Manual, so no photography would be allowed in the <u>standards development</u> portion of meetings, even if permission is granted by participants.

The IEEE SA Recording Policy is described in the IEEE SA Standards Board Operations Manual

Duty to Inform IEEE

- Participants <u>shall</u> inform the IEEE (or cause the IEEE to be informed) of the identity of each holder of any potential Essential Patent Claims of which they are personally aware if the claims are owned or controlled by the participant or the entity the participant is from, employed by, or otherwise represents
- Participants <u>should</u> inform the IEEE (or cause the IEEE to be informed)
 of the identity of any other holders of potential Essential Patent Claims

Early identification of holders of potential Essential Patent Claims is encouraged

Ways to Inform IEEE

- Cause an LOA to be submitted to the IEEE SA (patcom@ieee.org); or
- Provide the chair of this group with the identity of the holder(s) of any and all such claims as soon as possible; or
- Speak up now and respond to this Call for Potentially Essential Patents

If anyone in this meeting is personally aware of the holder of any patent claims that are potentially essential to implementation of the proposed standard(s) under consideration by this group and that are not already the subject of an Accepted Letter of Assurance, please respond at this time by providing relevant information to the WG Chair

Other Guidelines for IEEE WG's

- All IEEE SA standards meetings shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable laws, including antitrust and competition laws.
 - Don't discuss the interpretation, validity, or essentiality of patents/patent claims.
 - Don't discuss specific license rates, terms, or conditions.
 - Relative costs of different technical approaches that include relative costs of patent licensing terms may be discussed in standards development meetings.
 - Technical considerations remain the primary focus.
 - Don't discuss or engage in the fixing of product prices, allocation of customers, or division of sales markets.
 - Don't discuss the status or substance of ongoing or threatened litigation.
 - Don't be silent if inappropriate topics are discussed. Formally object to the discussion immediately.
