Summary:

The latest revision to IEEE-628, IEEE Standard Criteria for the Design, Installation, and Qualification of Raceway Systems for Class 1E Circuits for Nuclear Power Generating Stations, was published in March 2001. The current revision incorporated experienced-based seismic qualification methodology along with a general format update. Although the standard was Reaffirmed in December 2006, the Working Group will pursue a revision to address comments received during the reaffirmation process and to incorporate next generation nuclear plant design requirements as applicable. A timeline has been developed to prepare and issue the revision no later than December 2011, which is within the required 5-year cycle.

Membership Update:
