

Spouses / Companions Tour Neuschwanstein Castle & Fuessen

Date: Tuesday, March 19 Pick-up from the DOLCE Hotel Time: 8:30 am – 5:15 pm

Neuschwanstein Castle is one of the most popular of all the palaces and castles in Europe. Every year 1.3 million people visit "the castle of the fairy-tale king". In the summer around 6,000 visitors a day stream through rooms that were intended for a single inhabitant. The setting of the castle could not be more idyllic.

Neuschwanstein illustrates the ideals and longings of Ludwig II more vividly than any of his other buildings. The castle was not designed for royal representation, but as a place of retreat. Here Ludwig II escaped into a dream world – the poetic world of the Middle Ages. The picture cycles of Neuschwanstein were inspired by the operas of Richard Wagner, to whom the king dedicated the castle.

Have lunch at Schlossrestaurant Neuschwanstein, the nearest restaurant to the castle which accommodates guests since 1869 before you will go back to the hotel and tell your partner about this amazing place in Upper Bavaria.

Jeans and sneakers/tennis shoes will be commonplace!

Itinerary

8:30 am	Depart at DOLCE Hotel by bus with local tour guides
10:00 am – 12:15 pm	Walk to the castle (approx. 35 minutes by foot) and time to take photos
12:15 – 1:15 pm	Guided tour of the castle and free time for shopping at the gift shop
1:30 – 2:30 pm	Lunch at Schlossrestaurant (included 3-course menu and 3 softdrinks)
2:45 – 5:15 pm	Return to DOLCE Hotel by bus
