The three historic halls, today the buildings that house the Verkehrszentrum, were designed in 1907 by Wilhelm Bertsch and officially opened as exhibition halls in 1908. The halls mark the beginning of Munich's reputation as "Messestadt München", an ideal venue for trade fairs, and thus were an important part of the social and economic history of the city. As is demonstrated by the reinforced concrete structure of Hall 3, they also represent the innovative construction methods used around 1900.

Transport, traffic, and mobility are the most important basis of the economy and society. Even more, mobility is a basic function of human life and survival. At the turn of the 21st century, the world faces great challenges equally in transport and mobility issues.
