 - Category[I] gives the variable, which can further be indexed.
 - Fix up syntax at 399/402/405.
 - Add .Min/.Typ/.Max/.Meas
 - Discussion about "test environment" – how do Category/Selector actually get applied a la PatternExec? Much discussion about how (and whether) the test should establish an "environment" which would permit binding of all variables and specs to a specific value. We'll continue this discussion next week.
