## **Summary:**

Line numbers are with regard to syntax document dated August 28, 2012

- Line 756: some question as to whether Partition is the best term to use (Teradyne uses Slice). Decided to wait for feedback from Advantest, LTX, Teradyne
- Lines 778, 809: RECOMMEND: ACCEPT IIH, IIL, IOH, IOL, IOZH, IOZL, VIH, VIL, VOH, VOL, and add differential VOHD, VOHL, VIHD, VILD
- Line 947: EJW to rework example
- Line 1045: EJW to rework paragraph: all DCSequences including user-defined are legal, DCSequences no longer associated with TestProgram block
- Line 3535: ACCEPT "All mutable (non-const) objects are implicitly replicated per per site, i.e., no user action required. For example, for a tester with one testhead divided into two partitions, one with 2 sites, the other with 1, 3 copies of each mutable object exist. The set of mutable objects consists of variables, spec-variables, tests, soft bins, fail memory, and ...?"

NOTE: Discussions about multi-site issues are ongoing with SCSWG
