Syntax subgroup status:

- Still need another week to iron out the syntax before making presentation to full working group. Issues still needing work:
 - Binning (i.e., complex binning with logical combinations of softbins to hardbins).
 - On* entry points. Need to explicitly define the behavior of each of these.
 - Multi-site issues.
 - Do we need unique binmaps per site?
 - Do we need keywords to specify which operations can be done in parallel and which must be done serially?
 - Do we need the ability to run different test programs test programs on different sites? Do we need a "SiteManager" block in STIL .4? From Jose, STC has capability to run different test programs on different sites. There are a number of different scenarios:
 - Same test program running on all sites
 - Different test programs running on different sites (multi-project wafers, etc.).
 - Parallel testing of multiple circuit blocks within one die (seems to be more of a 1450.6 or 1500 issue to me).
 - Other scenarios?
 - Table of contents for ballot document – need someone to start working on this. Let's discuss this at next week's meeting.
