- Issues with VMeas and IMeas potentially being added to dot4 or dot5 (Tony)
 - .2 specifically did NOT include VMeas or IMeas. .3 currently addresses all TRC-related issues from .2 and and .0. The intent was the TestMethods (aka dot5, for which the PAR has been dropped, and which is inactive) would specify these. If there's any need to include these in dot3, Tony needs to know SOON. However, it's more likely that we'll either address these in a limited sense in dot4, or defer them to dot5 or the STIL user's group. In either case, the issue needs to be discussed.
- Need top 3 issues (from each WG member) identified with current spec by next meeting (Doug)
 - Review merged syntax/conceptual model document and issues/resolutions list. Identify your top 3 issues; forward to Jim
- Review attached merged conceptual (version K) and syntax (latest) doc (Doug)
 - Starting with the IEEE1450.1 standard as a template, conceptual model and syntax documents were combined into a single document.
 - The conceptual model is section 5 of the new document, while the syntax is section 6.
 - Where possible, terminology was reconciled between the two sections, using the "Reconciled Terminology" section of the 02/28/06 Rosetta Stone document (available on the .4 website). However, there is still much work to do in this area both in the conceptual model area itself (agreeing on what it is we want to

represent) and the syntax area (how to represent it in syntax). This is the top priority of the WG at this point.

- It was suggested that as we go through the reconciliation process, a glossary be added (and updated as needed) at the end of the document.
