Hi Dave,

I've outlined the next steps for the Standards Association (SA) balloting phase of development.

- 1. The draft must be submitted for Mandatory Editorial Coordination (MEC) review (approximately 30 days), and the draft will need to be updated based on the MEC review.
- 2. You will need to send the ballot invitation to form the ballot group (typically 30 days). Just note, that the SA ballot must start within 6 months of the closing date of the ballot invitation period. A second note, WG members, including officers, will need to join the ballot group. They are not automatically a part of the ballot group. Last note on the ballot group, ballot group members must have SA membership or pay a per-ballot fee to join the ballot group.
- 3. The Working Group (WG) must have a motion, second, and vote to request the initiation of the SA ballot from the Microprocessor Standards Committee (MSC).
- 4. The MSC will need to have a motion, second, and vote to approve the initiation of the SA ballot.
- 5. Once the steps above are approved are completed, the initial SA ballot can be launched. At the same time, the 60-Public Review period will also begin.

Steps 1 & 2 can be done simultaneously. I do have a presentation that I can give to the WG if you think there is value in that. I would just need to know when you think would be a good time/ meeting for the presentation so I can mark my calendar.
