 - o The following items from the table have been discussed:
 - Item 8: Using IETF interface-ref type seems preferable to using type string.
 - Suggestion for future discussion: deprecate the leaf “interface-name” and define a new leaf with a more fitting name of type interface-ref.
 - Decision: for now: change the type of leaf “interface-name” from type string to IETF type interface-ref.
 - An according maintenance item will be created. Action on Johannes.
 - Item 9: The leaf port-ref in dot1-q-types currently is defined as an integer. Similar to item 8 is suggested to use a port-ref type here instead of the integer.
 - There might exist multiple locations in the current IEEE 802.1 YANG modules where an IETF interface is referenced but an IEEE 802.1 port should be referenced instead. This needs to be clarified.
 - More discussion on this topic is needed.
