- 7.4 IEEE P802.11-95/05 Submission on conformance testing presented by Larry Zuckerman indicates that conformance testing can and should be performed via radiative instead of hardwired techniques. Decisions were deferred until after the presentation of the IOL.
- 7.5 Product Labeling John Sonnenberg introduced document 95/41 titled Product Labeling (John Sonnenberg, Pulse Engineering, and Wayne Moyers, Consultant). He showed a possible motion.

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Some dissension about labeling on the product itself was voiced. For labeling on enclosure 9, for labeling on selling box: 6. These counts includes counts on both.

7.67.5 Parameters IFS This item is delayed due to late arrival of paper.

7.77.6 Conformance 95/82 and 95/83 This item is delayed due to late arrival of paper.

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10.4 CONFORMANCE - Document 82 with Chris Zegelin. Proposed that all conformance measurement be done at the air interface. Praise for the concept but reservations <u>owing to lack of proofabout the specific wording</u>.

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
