#### Abstract

All recommendations of the May 1995 Letter Ballot passed. The ballot closed June 19, 70 persons returned their ballot, 66 were voting members. IEEE P802.11 had 84 voting members at the time the ballot started, so the ballot is valid as more than $50 \%$ of the voting members returned their ballot.

Two ballots were accompanied by comments. As a general reminder, I sent a reflector message on June 8, 1995 reminding the membership about the 2 pending ballots and on June 15, 1995, I warned all those voting members that had not returned their May ballots by e-mail and by phone. P.S. One ballot return is not included in this report. Roger Samdahl lost his membership due to not returning older ballots. He approved all questions.

## Comments

Comments from Ron Mahany:
My concern with this section is that the number of backoff slots [CWmin] was set at a level that was proposed but failed to gain majority approval (3-11 vote in MAC group) during the Salt Lake meeting. It appears that the text of $95 / 86$ was copied over verbatim without the necessary edits to make this parameter TBD. I'm sure that this was an oversight, as the editors were trying to get a lot down in very little time. If this were corrected, I'd have no objection to this section.

## Comments from Dave Bagby

On One envelope per company SITE:
I strongly object to this. mailings are to members of 802.11, individuals are members, NOT companies. in many cases, people from different locations and organizations within a company are members. It would be chaos for only one envelope to go to a company. Where would you send it? How would you decide? How would you know that members were notified of letter ballots? What would happen when they didn't vote because they didn't get the ballot? The only possible advantage I see for this suggestion is to save postage - and I disagree with that logic - use electronic means to save postage costs if needed. The fact is that postage is part of the cost of running a standards effort. If it is an issue to the sending company, then figure out what the cost is and add it into the meeting fees so that members share the cost, but do not send my mailing to someone else who happens to work for the same company I do. (Vic: would you like your mail to go to ATT world HQ?)

## On Motion 7

I disapprove for the following reasons:
The motion pertains to PHYs per the labels suggested. The wording is for "product claiming conformance"; suppose I was a consultant that wrote an 802.11 MAC software stack and tried to sell it... What is the product? why would I label it as 802.11 -"PHY"? Yet I would want to claim conformance to the 802.11 MAC spec I implemented. This entire motion is worthless until after the 802.11 conformance requirements are defined and adopted. Incorporation of this at this time will simply create a reason that I will have to vote no on the next sponsor LB.

## Comments from Simon Black

On IFS in sections 5.2.4, 5.2.1.3
$\mathrm{CW}_{\text {min }}=32$ not agreed during meeting. Evidence suggests a lower value would be more appropriate.
On Section 7
Power saving for ad-hoc networks completely removed. No letter ballot comment suggested this. New scheme required if PSNP not acceptable.
