

Nomination Period: 1 February–31 July

Awards Ceremony: Sunday, 8 December



- Nominators are encouraged to prepare the nomination before starting the electronic submission
- A successful nomination includes:
 - A candidate who meets the award criteria
 - Nominators are encouraged to look at the <u>criteria and eligibility requirements</u> of the award category for which a candidate is being nominated
 - A specific yet concise citation
 - The citation is the formal statement of the candidate's accomplishments, i.e., What is the individual or organization being nominated for?
 - A citation should be written so it can be displayed prominently as part of the award certificate, and read aloud easily at the awards ceremony
 - A specific description of how the candidate met the award criteria
 - Address all parts of each question completely to assure the selection committee has all the information it needs to know about your candidate (list on next slide)



- Include specific and concrete details—numbers, facts, examples, anecdotes—to describe the candidate's attributes and contributions
 - Explaining detailed behaviors and giving specific examples will clearly paint the picture of why someone deserves to be recognized
 - What organizations does the candidate belong to?
 - What leadership positions has the candidate assumed, both within IEEE SA and within the larger standards development community?
 - What projects has the candidate taken on/accomplished that demonstrate leadership, whether the candidate is/was officially in a leadership role or not?
- Share how the candidate reflects IEEE's core values and beliefs regarding service and provide examples
 - Choose one or two qualities that make this person/organization truly outstanding and then give specific examples



- Talk about challenges the candidate may have faced and how the candidate dealt with them
 - Share personal skills such as listening, teambuilding, collaboration, creativity, and professionalism
 - Share what stands out
 - What makes this person outstanding?
 - How have these accomplishments had an impact on people, the community, and the profession?
- Solicit endorsements from colleagues who will help the candidate be considered favorably
 - Supply helpful information to the writers of supporting letters
 - Contact endorsers ahead of time to notify them of the upcoming auto-generated email requests before submitting the nomination online



Important:

- · Read and understand the eligibility requirements and criteria for the award
- Prepare the nomination before starting the electronic submission
- Contact endorsers prior to finalizing and submitting the nomination
- If possible, please do not inform candidates that they are under consideration, since a limited number of recipients are chosen each year from among several worthy individuals

IEEE SA Awards FAQ

• Can I use any browser to submit a nomination?

The nomination platform works best in Chrome, Firefox, or Internet Explorer 11 and up

Are self-nominations allowed?
 Self-nominations are not allowed for IEEE SA award

When can I submit a nomination for an IEEE SA award?
 Nominations for IEEE SA awards are accepted from 1 February until 31 July

Are nominations confidential?

We ask that, if possible, nominators and endorsers do not inform candidates that they are under consideration, since a limited number of recipients are chosen each year from among several worthy individuals



IEEE SA Awards FAQ

Who can submit a nomination or endorsement? Who can be nominated?

- Any organization or person can be nominated. Candidates, nominators, and endorsers cannot currently be:
 - An employee of IEEE
 - An independent contractor to IEEE who is providing services to IEEE SA
 - A voting member of the <u>IEEE SA Board of Governors (BOG)</u>
 - A current member of IEEE SA Awards and Recognition Committee (ArCom)
 - Deceased (no posthumous nominations)
 - A past recipient of an award in the category for which the nomination is submitted
- Go to the specific award page to see the eligibility criteria for each award

Who are the judges?

 The IEEE SA Awards and Recognition Committee (ArCom) is responsible for administering the IEEE SA awards program. After the nomination period closes, ArCom acts on behalf of the BOG to receive nominations and recommend candidates for BOG approval, as appropriate, for IEEE standards awards



IEEE SA Awards FAQ

- Why do I need to login to complete a nomination form?
 Login allows nominators to track their nominations, and to send reminders to endorsers. This added feature is intended to provide secure connections, to assure your privacy and that of the candidates.



IEEE SA Conformity Assessment Award - for major contributions to the development and promotion of IEEE standards products through conformity



- The nomination form will appear
- Complete all candidate information
 - The top portion of the page includes information about the award
 - Scroll down to complete all candidate information
 - All items marked with a red asterisk * are required
 - Enter citation, and answer all required questions
 - Enter at least three endorsers (first name, last name; email address). Endorsers will automatically receive the letter of endorsement request once the nominator inputs his/her information. You may enter up to five endorsers
 - Click the SAVE AND NEXT button
 - This saves your nomination. A green pop-up box will appear in the top right corner of the screen to indicate "Success" and to confirm that your nomination was saved
 - You will be brought to the Nominating Party page

- All items marked with a red asterisk * are required

- Your nomination will NOT be submitted and will be classified as 'In Progress'

IMPORTANT

If possible, please do not inform candidates that they are under consideration, since a limited number of recipients are chosen each year from among several worthy individuals.

COMPLETING YOUR NOMINATION

By clicking "SAVE AND FINALIZE," your nomination will be submitted. A green pop-up box indicating "Success" will confirm your submission, and you will receive an automatically-generated email confirming that your nomination has been received.

By clicking "SAVE AND FINALIZE," you will send automatically-generated emails to your endorsers with a request and a link to either write or upload a letter of recommendation for your candidate.

You are encouraged to contact endorsers to notify them of the upcoming auto-generated email requests before submitting your nomination.

You must click "SAVE AND FINALIZE" before the 31 July deadline.

Clicking "SAVE" or "SAVE AND FINALIZE" enables you to save your current work and come back later to enter more data. No changes will be permitted after 31 July.

You may log into the nomination to check the status of letters received and send reminder emails to endorsers as needed. Endorsers must submit their letters by the 31 July deadline.






What happens after you click

SAVE AND FINALIZE

- Your nomination will be submitted and will be classified as 'Complete' and 'Pending Recommendation'. A green pop-up box will appear on the upper right corner of the screen to indicate "Success" to confirm submission of your nomination.
- A system email will be sent to you confirming your submission. You will no longer be able to edit your nomination. You will be able to view completed letters of endorsement.

Endorsers

Endorsements are most effective when from a company officer, program director, committee chair for a technical community or standards body, or a colleague, and, more generally, anyone who can attest and verify the Nominator's claims on the impact and individual role of the Nominee.

- Endorsers will receive an automatically generated email from Awards_no-reply@ieee.org
 - Subject line: Request for an endorsement letter
 - Includes a link to the endorsement form
- Complete Endorsement form
 - Type in the text box or attach an Endorsement letter
- Submit Endorsement
 - Click the 'Save' button at the bottom of the page to submit
 - You will not be able make edits after you submit the form



Endorsers

Letters that comment knowledgeably on the impact of the candidate's specific achievements are helpful, and endorsers are encouraged to provide any information that would be relevant to the nomination.

For example, endorsers may answer the following general questions:

- 1. What are the candidate's contributions that are deserving of recognition?
- 2. What is your relationship to the candidate, and how have you gained your knowledge of his/her contributions to the development of standards?
- 3. How has the candidate demonstrated leadership in identifying opportunities to better serve the needs of standards users?
- 4. If possible, please document the business, economic, and/or technical impact of the candidate's contributions.
- 5. If possible, please do not inform the candidate that they are under consideration, since a limited number of recipients are chosen each year from among several worthy individuals.




