Directions to Macau when you land in Hong Kong International Airport

- Before 22:00
 - Take the ferry inside the security area from the airport to Macau
 - It means you SHOULD NOT need to clear custom and claim your baggage
 - What you need to do is to pass your baggage tag/receipt to the casher when you buy your ticket.
 - The sales point is located at Transfer Area E2
 - Accept credit card
 - Please note that the ferry company needs to spend about 60 80 minutes to load your baggage from your aircraft to a ferry.
 - It means that you need to reserve at least 60 minutes before scheduled ferry departure time for ticketing and transfer procedures.
 - For passengers without checked baggage, 30 minutes would be sufficient.
 - There are 2 ferry companies serving ferries between Hong Kong International Airport and Macau
 - Cotai Water Jet, with Taipa Ferry Terminal as the destination
 - 3 trips per day: 11:45, 13:30, 16:15

 - Once you arrive in Macau, clear customs and then claim your baggage
- After 22:00 or you prefer to take ferry in downtown Hong Kong
 - Option 1 (Preferrable): Take taxi to Macau Ferry Terminal in Sheung Wan, Hong Kong Island
 - Clear custom and claim your baggage
 - Follow the signpost to go to Taxi Stand and take the "red" metered taxis
 - The other two taxis, blue and green, do not go to Hong Kong Island
 - Pay by cash, taxi drivers don't take either debit card or credit card
 - Once you arrive, go to 3/F to purchase tickets; accept credit card
 - Proceed to check-in gate
 - Proceed to immigration for clearance
 - Proceed to seat allocation counter for seat assignment
 - Board ferry

 - Clear custom and claim your baggage
 - Follow the signpost to go to Taxi Stand and take the "red" metered taxis
 - The other two taxis, blue and green, do not go to Kowloon
 - Pay by cash, taxi drivers don't take either debit card or credit card
 - Once you arrive, go to the designated ticket counters to purchase tickets
 - Proceed to check-in gate
 - Proceed to seat allocation counter for seat assignment
 - Proceed to immigration for clearance
 - Board ferry
 - There are 2 ferry companies serving ferries between Hong Kong Island and Macau
 - Cotai Water Jet, with Taipa Ferry Terminal as the destination
 - 5 trips per day: 0815, 0915, 1115, 1215, 1315
