- \$US 550.00 for all attendees
- Deadline: 6:00 PM Pacific Time, Friday, June 23, 2017

Late/On-site Registration

- \$US 750.00 for all attendees
- Applies to All Registrations AFTER: 6:00 PM Pacific Time, Friday, June 23, 2017
- Student Registration: \$US 150.00 (college student bachelor or post-graduate level)
- The Student meeting fee is available only one time per person.
- The person using the Student meeting fee will <u>not be able to use meeting attendance to gain or</u> <u>maintain voting rights</u>.
- A valid current student ID must be shown when picking up the meeting badge.
- The IEEE 802 Plenary Session Registration Rate is <u>not reduced for attendees staying at</u> <u>Estrel Hotel Berlin</u>.
