Major items discussed, decisions made and actions

Resolved 147 comments on draft 1.3

- \* Resolved to delete registers for OAM/UD channel in 10BASE-T1S
- \* Resolved to adopt improved preamble for 10BASE-T1S
- \* Resolved and removed TBDs and numerous editor's notes in the draft
- \* General clean up of management and registers for 10BASE-T1S and PLCA

Chartered draft 2.0 preparation and requested to progress to WG ballot

Reviewed and adopted new timeline

# Summary of Changes made to 802.3cg Preview Draft

- **General - Editorial cleanup** (e.g., all: - removing leftover “twisted pair” references, CI 22: “RS” for “Reconciliation Sublayer”, CI 45: Footer notes on tables with “R/W”, removal of Editor’s “reminder” notes, verb tenses, capitalization, etc.)
- **CI 30 & 45 - Inserting management parameters for PLCA** – max ID, Local Node ID, and TO Timer settings –registers and MIB objects.
- **CI 45 - Cleanup of (CI 45) register space for 10BASE-T1S** – deleted functions not relevant to T1S: training register, LPI monitors, PCS blocking, link status), resulted in deletion of T1S Training register and T1S PCS Status register 2)
- **CI 45 - Removal of OAM** register control and status for OAM channel for 10BASE-T1S. (CI 45) (Big ticket item)
- **CI 45 – Insertion of ‘multidrop mode’ status and control for T1S**
- **CI 45 – Insertion of missing PLCA reset bit** inadvertently omitted.
- **CI 146 – Editorial** (“can” for “may” and moving a label in Figure for alien crosstalk noise test), removal of editor’s notes from prior drafts, insertion of editor’s notes referencing cabling and IEC EMC test specifications under development, editorial on the link segment EMC/MICE tables (e.g., insertion of >=)
- **CI 147: Resolve timing TBDs** – including removal of “MBd” notation (confusing for DME and not necessary)
- **CI 147: Adoption of revised preamble (JJHH)** and associated text (mainly in PCS receive)
- **CI 147: Editorial** - Insertion of block diagram figures and removal of editor’s notes
- **CI 147: PMA transmit voltage specifications**
- **CI 147: Insertion of alien crosstalk rejection test and figure**
- **CI 147: PHY delay specification**
- **CI 148: Text related to management parameters for PLCA** (above) and removal of editor’s notes.

- ✓ September 2017 – Baselines selected, draft 0.9 for Task Force Review
- ✓ **November 2017 – Last features selected - Task Force Review D1.0**
  - Nov:D1.0, Jan:D1.1, ~~possible Feb 2018 extra off-cycle interim, D1.2~~
- March 2018 – **Complete Task Force Review(D1.2/1.3)** [ *Task Force review to continue* ]
- May 2018 – Draft 2.0, enter working group ballot** (2 recircs: July:D2.1, Sept:D2.2) [*Probably at least July*]
- Nov 2018 – D3.0 – enter Sponsor ballot** (2 recircs Jan'19:D3.1, Mar'19:D3.2)
- June 2019 Standards Board approval**
