Dear Dr. Oehler,

We would like to thank you for your communication 3N1300. The IEEE P802.3da 10SPE Multidrop Enhancements (SPMD) Task Force is in the process of creating a draft ready for Task Force review. As such, the draft has not yet achieved a state that warrants sharing outside the Task Force. The first version of a draft that can be shared will still be a Task Force review draft, so it will still be early in the 802.3 process. IEEE 802.3 will inform ISO/IEC JTC1/SC25 WG3 when the draft is stable enough to share.
