Proposed 802 Policies and Procedures for Coexistence Assurance (1)

- Presented P&P changes at Sunday Evening 802 Rules meeting
- Modified proposed changes based on feedback from executive committee
- As requested, presented proposed 802 P&P changes to several wireless WGs
 - 802.11
 - 802.15
 - 802.16

Proposed 802 Policies and Procedures for Coexistence Assurance (2)

- Motion at Friday closing EC meeting to hold EC letter ballot on proposed P&P changes. Motion passed 13/0/1
- Next step is to hold 30-day EC letter ballot
- Then make necessary text changes in response to EC letter ballot comments
- Motion at November Plenary to accept 802 P&P changes
