The following is the Clause 14 'Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard' report for IEEE P802.3ba 40 Gb/s and 100 Gb/s Ethernet which received conditional approval to proceed to RevCom submittal at the March 2010 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.
