The following is the Clause 13 'Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard' report for IEEE P802.3bc Ethernet Organizationally Specific type, length, values (TLVs) which received conditional approval for submission to RevCom at the July 2009 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

a) Recirculation ballot is completed. Generally, the recirculation ballot and resolution should occur in accordance with the schedule presented at the time of conditional approval.

Recirculation balloting is complete.

The schedule presented to the July 2009 closing IEEE 802 EC meeting when requesting conditional approval was:

Draft 3.0 of IEEE P802.3bc will begin a recirculation ballot on or before 27th July 2009, recirculation will close no later than 10th August July 2009. Comment resolution to be conducted on 12th August 2009.

BALLOT OPEN: Thursday, 23rd July 2009

BALLOT CLOSE: Thursday, 6th August 11:59PM EDT

The only comment received was an editorial coordination comment that reads 'This recirculation meets all editorial requirements.'. Based on this being the only comment received the planned comment resolution meeting for 12th August has been cancelled.

The recirculation balloting is complete and ballot occurred in accordance of the plan presented.

b) After resolution of the recirculation ballot is completed, the approval percentage is at least 75% and there are no new DISAPPROVE votes.

The ballot results after resolution are:

Voters: 101 Approve: 86 Disapprove: 1 Abstain: 5 Returns: 92

Response Rate: 91% Approval Rate: 98%

The approval rate of the ballot is greater than 75% and there were no new negative DISAPPROVES votes.
