P0060r1 – "Recommended Practice on Digital Twin Modelling and Analysis Based on Spatialp-temporal Data of Switch Cabinet and Transformer 110kV and below" – Ryan Musgrove, Power Transformers SC Chair will review and provide recommendation.

P0092 – "Recommended Practice for Electromagnetic Compatibility Test of Electronic Instrument Transformers and connected IEDs (Intelligent Electronic Devices)" – Thomas Sizemore, Instrument Transformers SC Chair will review and provide recommendation.

P0103 – "Guide for Vibration Test of Direct-Current (DC) converter Transformer Section 3", Ulf Radbrandt, HVDC SC Chair will review and provide recommendation.

- 17.11.1 Bushings Subcommittee | Eric Weatherbee
- 17.11.1.1 There are four active pars, 2 are in ballot and 2 expire at the end of the year.
- 17.11.2 Dielectric Test Subcommittee | Poorvi Patel
- 17.11.2.1 There are two PAR extensions. The bushing Entity PAR will go through. The PAR for PC57.138 was approved and the first working group meeting will be this week.
- 17.11.3 Distribution Transformers Subcommittee | Ed Smith
- 17.11.3.1 Craig Colopy is recognized for his tireless work on standards development. Craig is nearing retirement and requested to be relieved of his WG Chair of C57.15. Dan Sauer has agreed to take over the C57.15 chair position. C57.12.34 is expiring at the end of this year, Steve Shull will lead the PAR study group.
- 17.11.4 Dry Type Transformers Subcommittee | Casey Ballard
- 17.11.4.1 One document made it to SA ballot. One WG Chair wants to run meetings entirely virtually. This was made known to all members and guests of the SC and will also be communicated to the committee at the general meeting on Monday at the general meeting.
- 17.11.5 HVDC Converter Transformers & Reactors Subcommittee | Ulf Radbrandt
- 17.11.5.1 Two standards were published in 2017 and 2020. There is upcoming standards development for this SC which will be undertaken at upcoming Committee meetings in 2023.
- 17.11.6 Instrument Transformers Subcommittee | Thomas Sizemore
- 17.11.6.1 There will be no meeting of the SSBT group at the TC meeting this week. However, the CCVT group will meet this week. These schedule changes will be announced at the general committee meeting on Monday.
- 17.11.7 Insulating Fluids Subcommittee | Scott Reed
- 17.11.7.1 There are 7 active Working Groups and 1 Task Force. C57.166 has requested a PAR extension. C57.104 has not had a meeting at the last two main Committee meetings since none of the officers have attended the meeting.

- 17.11.8 Insulation Life Subcommittee | Jinesh Malde (for Sam Sharpless)
- 17.11.8.1 There are seven Working Groups meeting this week. See the meeting schedule for times and location of each group. C57.91 will meet and plan to go to ballot this fall. C57.100 completed balloting. C57.154 was published. C57.162 is in ballot and has a PAR extension. C57.165 will request the SC this week to go to ballot. C57.169 the first ballot was performed with good results.
- 17.11.9 Performance Characteristics Subcommittee | Rogerio Verdolin
- 17.11.9.1 The PCS subcommittee has four Working Groups and 3 Task Forces meeting this week, see the meeting schedule for the meeting times and location.
- 17.11.10 Power Transformers Subcommittee | Ryan Musgrove
- 17.11.10.1 The subcommittee has 13 meetings this week, seven Working Groups and 6 Task Forces. Help is needed to get expertise in reviewing documents. Standard 638 is not meeting this week but should have a meeting soon. C57.15 is looking for expertise to help review the arc furnace transformer standard.
- 17.11.11 Standards Subcommittee | Dan Sauer
- 17.11.11.1 PC57.12.80 extended the PAR again, approval to go to ballot is needed at this meeting to move the work ahead. C57.152 expires next year so the work needs to progress.
- 17.11.12 Subsurface Transformers & Network Protectors Subcommittee | George Payerle
- 17.11.12.1 There are three Working Groups to finish their work in the next year. There is a new WG on subsurface transformers.
