Patricians and bishops, demons and saints, citizens and craftsmen have left their mark on Regensburg's colorful history. Discover the major landmarks and monuments of one of the most important towns during the Middle Ages and listen to vivid stories and legends of the people of Regensburg. Since 2006 the Old Town of Regensburg holds the status of an UNESCO World Heritage Site. The City's unique character as "the only authentically preserved large medieval city in Germany" and its outstanding historic significance are the reasons why. During the tour you will learn everything about the stone bridge, the cathedral St. Peter and what the legends says about the builders pact with the devil...
