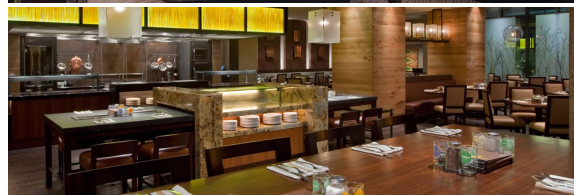
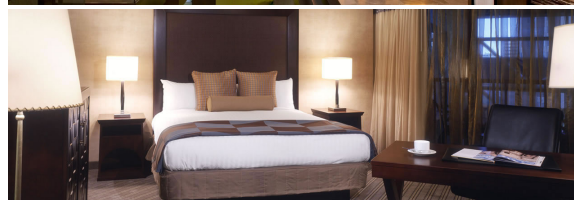
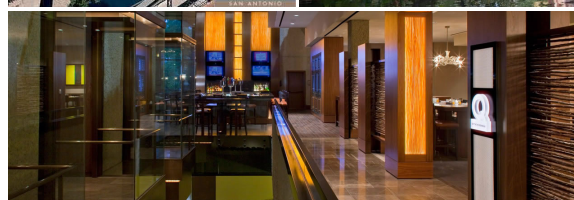
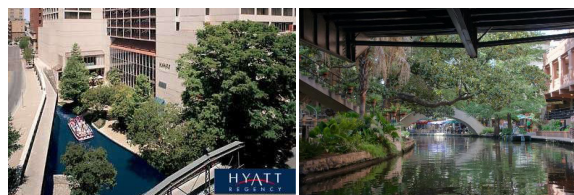
ROOM RESERVATIONS:
