**Fallingwater** 

Monday morning is all about
Fallingwater, one of the greatest
architectural triumphs of the
20th century. Since its public
debut 82 years ago, more than five

million visitors have toured this unique structure now designated as a National Historic Landmark and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Treasure.

Fallingwater was designed by Frank Lloyd Wright in 1935 as a private residence and weekend home for the family of Pittsburgh department store owner, Edgar J. Kaufmann. One of Wright's most widely acclaimed works, it best exemplifies his philosophy of organic architecture: the harmonious union of art and nature. Fallingwater is also the only major Wright work to come into the public domain with its setting, original furnishings and artwork attached. www.fallingwater.org
