# **Additional Factory Tour Information and Restrictions**

#### Age Restrictions:

- Children under 5 are not permitted on the factory portion of the tour.
- Children under 15 must be accompanied by an adult on the factory portion of the tour.

#### Dress Code and Personal Items:

- Small clutches (max size 4.5" x 6.5") and outerwear (coats, vests, sweaters) are permitted in the factory. A limited number of lockers are available for personal item storage while on tour.
- Hairnets and beard nets (if applicable) must always be worn in the factory.

#### Animals:

- · No animals, including service animals, are allowed on the factory portion of the tour.
- Food and Beverages:
