Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza & Dallas Museum of Art

Tuesday, March 13



Tuesday you will experience a taste of Dallas. You will start with a tour of the Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza. It provides a comprehensive exhibit on the life, death, and legacy of President John F. Kennedy. The Museum's exhibition area uses historic films, photographs, artifacts, and interpretive displays to document the events of the assassination, the findings of the official investigations that followed, and the historical legacy of that national tragedy.

You will also visit Dealey Plaza and the grassy knoll in Dealey Plaza, where JFK's motorcade was located when he was shot.

Lunch will be in the Atrium Café at the Dallas Museum of Art.



Afterwards you will have a docent-led tour at the Dallas Museum of Art. The DMA features an outstanding collection of more than 23,000 works of art from around the world, from ancient to modern times. Now on display is a special exhibition "Matisse - Painter as Sculptor".
